JACK HORNER'S PLUM PIE



INGREDIENTS

2 unbaked pie crusts
2 lbs plums
1/2 cup sugar
2 tablespoons flour
1 teaspoon cinnamon
1 tablespoon butter

DIRECTIONS

1. Preheat oven to 450° F.
2. Place one pie crust into a 9-inch pie dish.
3. Wash plums, do not peel.
4. Cut plums in half, remove pit, then cut into quarters.
5. Arrange plums in the pie crust.
6. Mix together the dry ingredients, then sprinkle over the plums.
7. Dot with the butter.
8. Place top crust over plums, trim crust edges with enough to turn under the rim, then crimp crust edge.
9. Cut about 9 to 12 1-inch slits into the top of the pie.
10. Bake at 450° F for 12 minutes, reduce heat to 325° F, bake 25 minutes longer or until plums are tender.
11. Cool, serve warm or cold.



GOLDILOCKS' PORRIDGE



INGREDIENTS

- 2 ½ cups water
- 1 cup rolled oats
- 1 tablespoon white sugar
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 pinch ground cinnamon
- 1 cup berries
- ½ cup cold milk (optional)

DIRECTIONS

1. Combine water, oats, cinnamon, sugar, and salt in a saucepan.
2. Bring to a boil, then reduce heat to low, and simmer until the liquid has been absorbed, stirring frequently.
3. Pour into bowls.
4. Top each with berries.
5. As an option, top with a splash of cold milk.



SOFTPAWS' TRES LECHES



INGREDIENTS

1 box yellow cake mix
4 eggs
1 $\frac{1}{3}$ cups whole milk
 $\frac{1}{2}$ cup butter
3 teaspoons vanilla
14-ounce can sweetened condensed milk
12-ounce can evaporated milk

For topping

2 cups heavy whipping cream
 $\frac{1}{4}$ cup powdered sugar
1 teaspoon vanilla
 $\frac{1}{4}$ teaspoon cinnamon powder
1 cup strawberries

DIRECTIONS

1. Preheat the oven to 350° F and spray a 9x13 baking dish with non-stick cooking spray.
2. Using a stand mixer, stir together the cake mix, eggs, milk, butter, and vanilla.
3. Pour the batter into the baking dish and bake for 40 minutes.
4. Let the cake cool completely after baking.
5. Whisk together the sweetened condensed milk, evaporated milk, and the whole milk in a medium-sized bowl.
6. Set the bowl aside and use a knife to cut slits all over the top of the cake. Slowly pour the milk mixture evenly over the cake. The milk mixture will seep into the slits as it covers the cake.
7. Place the cake in the fridge to chill for at least two hours to soak up the milk mixture.
8. Make the whipped topping by beating the heavy whipping cream, powdered sugar, and vanilla until stiff peaks form.
9. Finally, spread the whipped topping over the cake with a rubber scraper.
10. Dust the top with cinnamon and garnish with sliced strawberries.



PERRITO'S PET TREATS

Great snacks for dogs and humans alike!



INGREDIENTS

2½ cups whole wheat flour

1 large egg

1 cup peanut butter

1 cup water

2 tablespoons honey

For frosting

2 tablespoons peanut butter

1 tablespoon honey

¼ cup cornstarch

3-4 tablespoons water

DIRECTIONS

1. Preheat oven to 350°F. Line a baking sheet with parchment paper. Set aside.
2. In a large bowl, combine flour and the egg. Add the peanut butter, water, and honey, and stir until you have a stiff dough.
You may need to use your hands or the paddle attachment on your mixer.
3. On a lightly floured surface, roll out the dough about ½ inch thick and use a cookie cutter to make fun shapes.
4. Bake for 18-20 minutes, until golden. Once done, set aside to cool. *(If you have smaller cookies, use less time, otherwise the bottom might burn.)*
5. Make the frosting by combining the peanut butter and honey in a microwavable bowl, and heat in the microwave in 15 second increments, stirring in between, until melted.
6. Add the melted peanut butter mixture to the cornstarch and stir until just combined.
7. Slowly add in the water one tablespoon at a time until you have reached the consistency that you would like. For a thinner frosting, add more water.
8. Add the frosting to a piping bag and pipe designs on top of each treat.

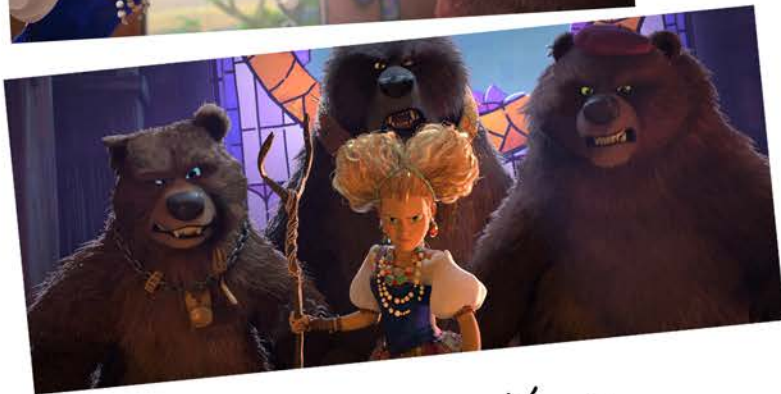


FINGER ART

Ruler

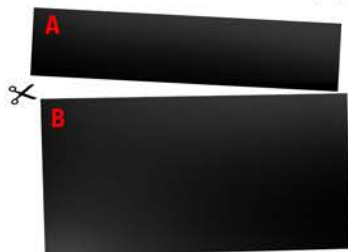
Feather

1. Cut 1/3 of black construction paper.



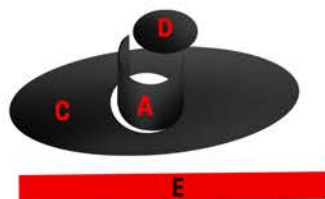
2. Cut out an ellipse.

3. Slot the end of the cardboard tube through the strip.
4. Bend the strip and glue it to the bottom of the cardboard tube.
5. Wrap the "blade" with aluminum foil.

MAKE A PAPER PERRITO

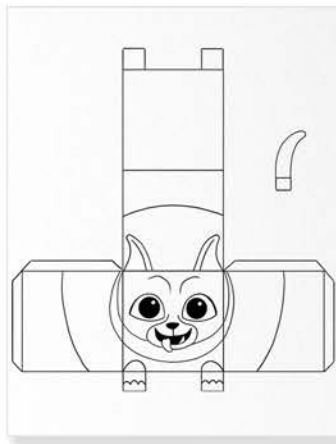

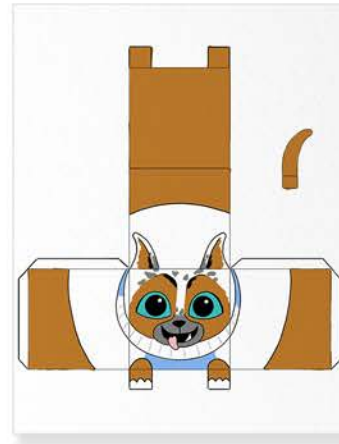
Cardstock or thick paper

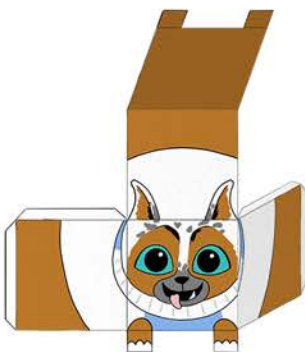
1. Using the template on the next page, draw Perrito following the guide below.



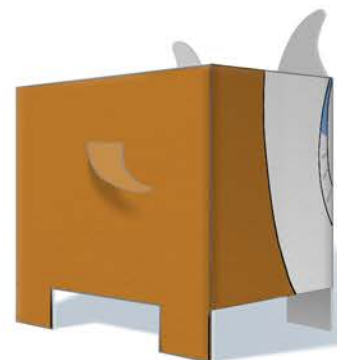
2. Color Perrito. Make him extra wacky by adding googly eyes!

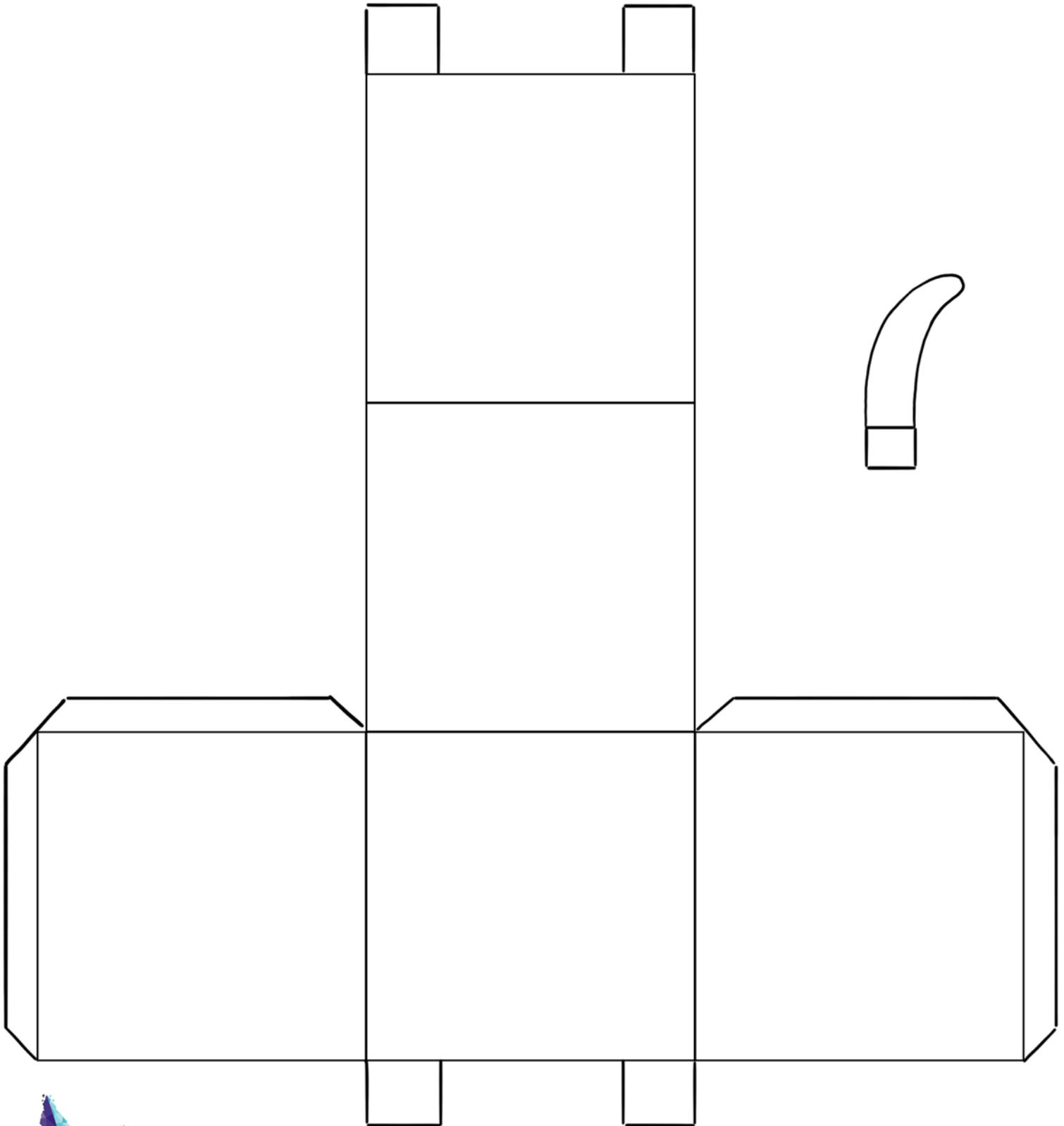


3. Using scissors, carefully cut out the template. Fold along the lines and flaps to make a cube.

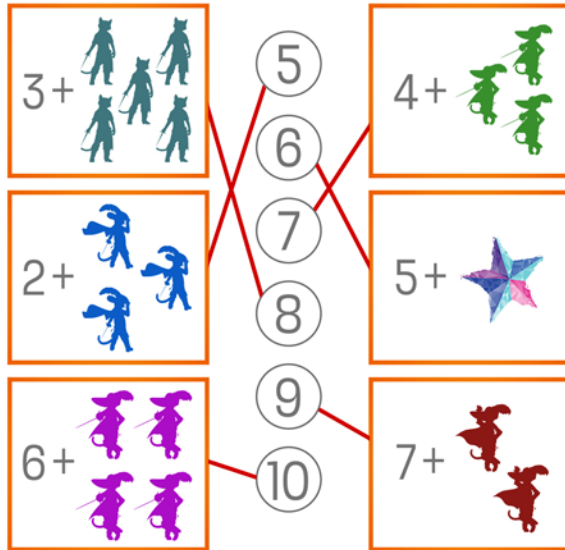


4. Apply the gluestick to the flaps and firmly join them to the edges to create your cube. And last but not least, glue on his tail.

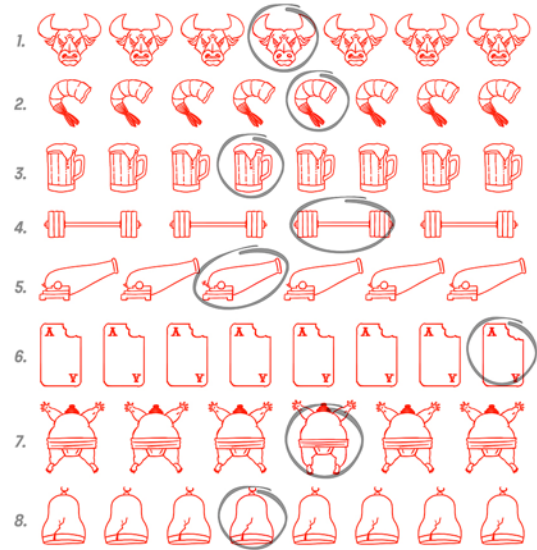
